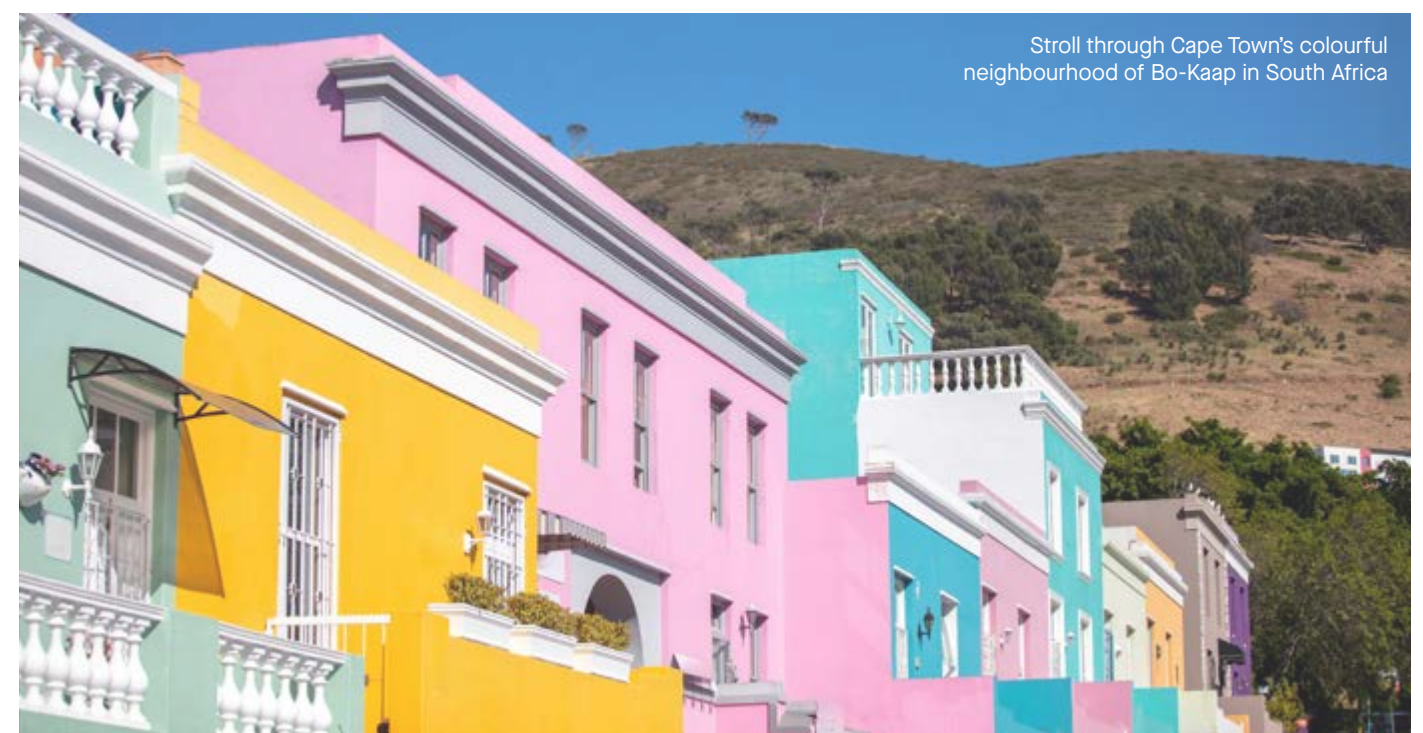

Itinerary

Day 01: Arrive Cape Town We'll greet you on arrival and transfer you to your hotel, affectionately known by locals and regulars as 'Mount Nellie'. Situated at the foot of Table Mountain, this exquisitely restored colonial hotel was painted its distinctive shade of pink in 1918. This evening, meet your fellow travel companions and APT Tour Director at a welcome dinner. **D**

Three Nights: Cape Town, Belmond Mount Nelson Hotel.

Day 02: Cape Town Savour a delicious breakfast at your hotel before starting your guided tour with a visit to the District Six museum. Explore powerful exhibitions that shed light on the deeply moving history of Cape Town during the Apartheid era. Then, ride the aerial cableway to the top of Table Mountain. This evening, choose where to dine. **BD**

Day 03: Cape Town, Cape Peninsula Embark on a breathtaking journey along Chapman's Peak Drive, one of the world's most scenic stretches of road. Soak up views of the spectacular coast en route to the southernmost tip of Africa, Cape Point. Continue to Simon's Town for lunch before exploring Boulders Beach, home to a vivacious colony of penguins. **BL**

Day 04: Cape Town, Stellenbosch Decide how to explore today with a range of Freedom of Choice sightseeing activities on offer. Perhaps venture to Robben Island and learn about the prison where Nelson Mandela was incarcerated from 1964 to 1982, or take a tour of the colourful neighbourhood of Bo-Kaap. Alternatively, visit Brundyn Arts and Culture, walk along the Victoria & Alfred (V&A) Waterfront, and enjoy a rooftop drink at the iconic Silo Hotel. Afterwards, head to the historic town of Stellenbosch and spend the afternoon relaxing at the opulent Lanzerac Hotel, framed by magnificent mountain scenery. **BD**

Two Nights: Stellenbosch, Lanzerac Hotel.

Day 05: Stellenbosch Discover the colonial history and Cape Dutch architecture of Stellenbosch on a walking tour, then taste traditional South African dishes like bobotie and Amarula mousse. Spend the rest of the day enjoying your accommodation's amenities. Perhaps take a stroll through the grounds or indulge in a spa treatment (additional expense). **BL**

Day 06: Stellenbosch, Kruger National Park Fly to Kruger and transfer to your luxurious private lodge, nestled within the sprawling 15,000-hectare Kapama

Private Game Reserve in Kruger National Park. Home to 40 different mammal species, including the spotted hyena and greater kudu, plus over 300 bird species, the reserve offers countless opportunities for wildlife viewing. This evening, unwind with a round of sundowners as you bask in a breathtaking African sunset, followed by a sumptuous dinner. **BD**

Three Nights: Kruger National Park, Kapama River Lodge or similar.

Day 07: Kruger National Park Rise early for a morning game drive, which presents the perfect opportunity to spot animals roaming in the wild, such as giraffes, birdlife and the Little Five (elephant shrew, antlion, rhinoceros beetle, buffalo weaver and leopard tortoise). Then, head back to your lodge to relax before a game drive in the afternoon. Tonight, indulge in a mesmerising boma dinner under the stars. Soak up the unique ambience of open-air candlelit dining in the heart of the African bush, accompanied by traditional song and dance. **BLD**

Day 08: Kruger National Park Perhaps join a bushwalk to learn about local medicinal fauna and look out for animal tracks. Later, enjoy a thrilling 4WD game drive followed by a sundown toast. **BLD**

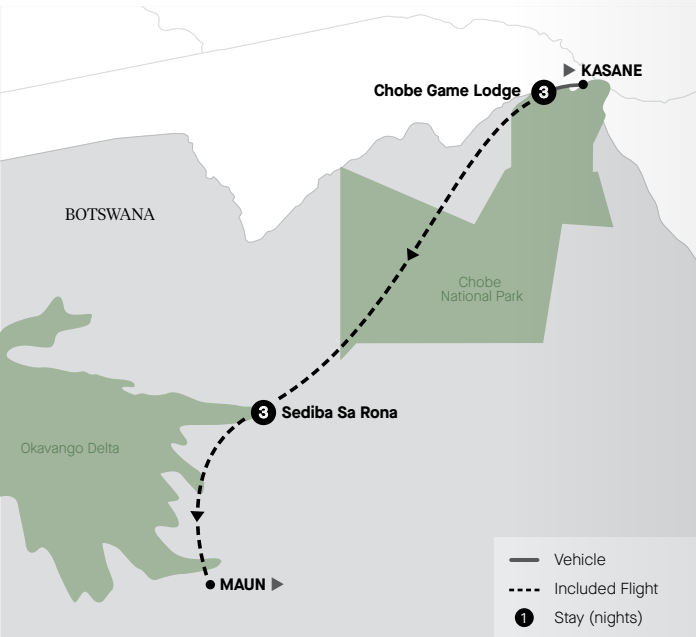

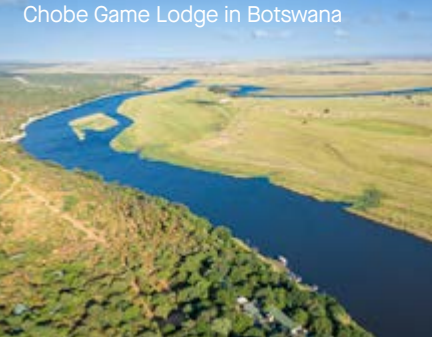
