## ALPINE WONDERS

Switzerland's railways are masterpieces of precision and scenery. Board the Jungfrau Railway from Grindelwald to Jungfraujoch, where the route weaves through the mountains to reveal sweeping views of the Aletsch Glacier and the Bernese Alps. On the GoldenPass Express, travel across alpine valleys past lakeside villages, then follow the historic Gotthard Panorama Express route along dramatic gorges and mountain passes. Settle into the slow elegance of the Glacier Express, featuring panoramic carriages that glide across the Landwasser Viaduct. Equally

spectacular is the Bernina Express, winding from St. Moritz to Tirano across the iconic Brusio Spiral Viaduct, linking Swiss alpine tradition with Italian warmth.

## ITALIAN ICONS

Journey through Italy's cultural heart, from the ancient wonders of Rome and Pompeii to the coastal beauty of Sorrento. Travel north by rail from Naples to Florence, then continue onward to Venice, where a high-speed train carries you through rolling Tuscan countryside before arriving in the iconic floating city at the head of the Adriatic.

In the Scottish Highlands, be left in awe by an amphitheatre of steely lochs, coastal meadows and enchanting glens as you travel along the West Highland line. You'll also step aboard The Jacobite steam train, known as the Hogwarts Express in the *Harry Potter* films. This legendary train passes Ben Nevis and climbs into mountains, steaming across the Glenfinnan Viaduct on its approach to Mallaig, the final leg of the West Highland line. The Kyle of Lochalsh line, completed in 1897, links Scotland's east and west coast, carving a path through some of the Highlands' most dramatic scenery. The route is an engineering marvel as much as it is a showcase of landscape, with its final stretch between Stromferry and Kyle of Lochalsh cut through solid rock via 31 cuttings and 29 bridges.

## STUNNING SCANDINAVIA

Experience Scandinavia by rail aboard high-speed trains linking Copenhagen, Stockholm and Oslo with Norway's dramatic fjord country. Travel on one of Norway's most celebrated railways, the Bergen Railway, which climbs from sea level onto the vast Hardangervidda plateau, crossing Europe's highest mainline railway and revealing sweeping views of rugged plateaus and fjord-cut valleys. Visit Craigievar Castle, then continue to the royal village of Braemar and the Braemar Highland Games Centre. **Day 5. Aberdeen, Keith, Inverness** Depart Aberdeen this morning and board your train northwest towards Inverness. On arrival in Mallaig, enjoy time at leisure to explore the harbour village, known for its fishing heritage and fresh seafood, before returning to Fort William.  
**Stay:** Fort William, Cruachan Hotel or similar. B

**Day 9. Fort William, Arrochar, Glasgow** Head south from Fort William aboard the West Highland Line as you make your way to Arrochar near the head of Loch Long. From here, visit the picturesque village of Luss on the shores of Loch Lomond, known for its charming cottages. Continue by coach along the banks of Loch Lomond to Glasgow.
