General Questions

When is the best season to travel in Canada?

In our eyes, it's always a pleasure to travel to Canada. From April to May, snow is visible, and lakes are still frozen from winter. Bears emerge from hibernation, and national parks are busy with wildlife. Summer is from June to August, and it's the most popular season for outdoor activities and wildlife viewing. In autumn, from September to November, temperatures cool and the leaves change. In winter, from December to early March, the landscape transforms into a breathtaking wonderland.

Will I see wildlife?

Most of our tours take place between April and September, when wildlife is at its most abundant and active. All our holidays visit national parks for the best chance to see wildlife, including bears, wolves and bald eagles.

On a cruise through Alaska's Inside Passage, it's likely you will see marine and land mammals from aboard your ship. For a closer look, however, we recommend you book shore excursions that include visits to wilderness parks.

Will I have Wi-Fi access?

Free Wi-Fi is available on coaches in Canada and the USA. As coaches use a satellite system, routing may cause restricted reception. Wi-Fi is also available in most hotels and all Fairmont properties, and is available for purchase on Holland America Line cruises. Wi-Fi is not available on coaches in Alaska.

What time is hotel check-in and check-out?

Hotel check-in is usually at 4pm. Where possible, the hotel will try to have your room ready earlier. To guarantee early check-in, you will need to book an additional night prior to your scheduled arrival (additional expense). Hotel check-out is at 11am or noon.

What clothing should I pack?

Pack a variety of clothing to suit the time of year in which you're travelling. Most guests dress casually during the day, but we recommend that you pack an array of comfortable light to medium weight clothes, plus rainwear. If you are travelling in winter, you will need to bring clothes that can be layered, and a waterproof outer layer, as temperatures can drop to lows of between -15 and -40 degrees Celsius. Ensure you have appropriate footwear.

Rocky Mountaineer

How long is my Rocky Mountaineer rail journey?

You will spend two days on board Rocky Mountaineer, travelling around 450 kilometres each day in Canada, all in daylight.

Which route will I be travelling?

'First Passage to the West' journeys operate both east and westbound between Vancouver and Lake Louise or Banff. You'll travel through the Canadian Rocky Mountains, past Kicking Horse River, through the Spiral Tunnels and over the Continental Divide along the Canadian Pacific track.

'Journey Through the Clouds' takes you between Vancouver and Jasper, past some of the tallest peaks in the Canadian Rockies, including Mount Robson. You'll travel through remote countryside alongside the Coast Mountains, Fraser Canyon, Albretha Glacier and Pyramid Falls.

Please check individual itineraries for the direction of travel.

What is the baggage size allowance on board?

Only hand luggage is permitted on the Rocky Mountaineer and you will not have access to checked luggage while on board the train. Your checked luggage will be delivered to your overnight accommodation in Kamloops. Please ensure everything you'll need during the rail journey is packed in your hand luggage, and everything you can do without is securely stowed away.

VIA Rail

How long is my VIA Rail journey?

The overnight journey from Vancouver to Jasper takes approximately 18.5 hours.

What are the cabin facilities on VIA Rail?

Your VIA Rail journey will be in Sleeper Plus class. By night, your private twin cabin features an upper and lower bed. By day, the cabin features two seats facing each other. A private washroom is available inside each cabin and guests have access to a shared shower room. For single cabins, enquire for further details.

What is the baggage size allowance on board?

If your holiday includes a rail journey on VIA Rail, you will be required to pack down to an overnight bag (max 11kg). You will not have access to checked luggage during your rail journey.

Prices will be confirmed at time of booking and honoured for up to seven days. All holidays are subject to availability at the time of booking.

Credit and Debit Card Surcharges

If you pay APT by credit or debit card, surcharges will apply. In the case of credit cards, a surcharge of between 1% and 3% (depending on the card used) is added to the tour price. In the case of debit cards, a charge of 0.5% is added to the tour price.

Travel Insurance

Travel insurance is not included in your holiday package. For peace of mind, we strongly recommend that you purchase appropriate fully comprehensive travel insurance suitable for your trip. For some destinations Travel Insurance is mandatory, please refer to the website for your destinations requirements.

Airfares

Air travel is arranged with independent airlines. APT will arrange air travel as advertised in connection with your holiday package. All airfares are subject to flight and class availability and will be booked on receipt of your deposit to avoid price or tax increases. Once air tickets are issued, amendment and cancellation fees and conditions apply and, in some cases, are non-refundable.

Transfers

Airport transfers are included on the first and last day of the holiday package and may be at designated times. They are not refundable if not used and cannot be re-routed. Other than the included transfer, all other transfers are at the travellers' own expense.

Freedom of Choice

Minimum and maximum group numbers apply on some Freedom of Choice tours. If your first choice is not available, you may be asked to choose an alternative.

Cancellation Policy

Limitation of Liability

Our holiday packages include the services of independent providers, such as hoteliers, airlines, cruise companies and other operators, who are not agents or employees of APT. APT is not responsible for the conduct of the independent providers or their agents or for any ramifications of that conduct. APT accepts no responsibility for any death, injury, illness, loss, damage, detention, or delay beyond its control. Any term, condition or warranty expressed or implied by statute or otherwise in respect of the holiday packages contained in any of our collateral are excluded to the full extent permitted by law. Nothing in our terms and conditions excludes, restricts or modifies the application of the Competition and Consumer Act 2010 (Cth) as amended. To the full extent permitted by law, APT's liability arising under or in connection with these booking conditions:

(a) is limited to the re-supply of the products or services or the payment of the cost of re-supply of the products or services to you; and (b) excludes liability for any indirect or consequential losses suffered by you or any third party, howsoever caused.

Force Majeure

Force Majeure event means the occurrence of an event that is beyond APT's reasonable control, and which could not have been reasonably prevented by APT. For a non-exhaustive list of examples of Force Majeure events, please see our full Terms and Conditions.

Termination of Booking Contract or Change of Travel Arrangements Due to Force Majeure

If APT, in its reasonable opinion, considers that

any Force Majeure event prevents APT (directly, or through its employees, contractors, subcontractors and agents) from lawfully or safely providing any products or services subject of the booking contract with you, APT may immediately by written notice: (a) terminate the booking contract (in whole or in part); or (b) change your travel arrangements as reasonably practicable to ensure your safety and invoice you for any additional costs.

Limitation of Liability in the Case of Force Majeure

If APT cancels or changes your travel arrangements in any way due to a Force Majeure event, APT will not be liable to you in contract, tort, statute or restitution for any loss (including, but not limited to, loss of deposit or purchase price and loss of enjoyment), damage, costs, charges, expenses or injury resulting from or in connection with (whether directly or indirectly): (a) the cancellation or change to your travel arrangements; or (b) the Force Majeure event. APT is not liable to refund any part of the deposit or purchase price paid by you if APT subsequently changes or cancels your travel arrangements in connection with a Force Majeure event. As you are required to purchase travel insurance to adequately protect yourself against these risks, your policy needs to respond to these risks.

APT does not employ medical staff on its tours. If you require medical attention, local medical services can be contacted immediately. You are responsible for all medical fees.
