Adapters and Electricity

We recommend you bring an international travel adaptor to use on board our cruises. For safety reasons, hair irons and clothes irons cannot be used in staterooms. Hair dryers are provided in each stateroom.

Beverages

Aboard Seabourn Venture, Seabourn Pursuit, Coral Adventurer, Coral Discoverer, and MV Lady Eleganza, all-day complimentary premium spirits, beer and wine are available at all times. Guests cannot bring their own alcohol. Alcohol is not permitted in some areas visited.

Clothing

The dress code on our cruises and tours is relaxed, but smart casual clothing for evenings on board is recommended. You may wish to bring something a little dressier for the captain's dinners and cocktail evenings; however, there will be no black tie or formal evenings.

When packing, consider the season of the destination that you're traveling to. We recommend layering your clothing so that you can be prepared for changes in weather conditions throughout the day. Sturdy footwear is essential, and wet shoes are highly recommended on some tours.

For expedition cruises in the Kimberley, it is essential to bring shoes that can get wet (e.g. reef shoes or rubber sandals), are comfortable for walking in, and

for wet landings on shore. Flip flops are not suitable. Your luggage should include a windproof/waterproof jacket, walking trousers/shorts, and a hat with a brim. On Antarctic expedition cruises, all guests receive a complimentary polar parka to use during the voyage and to keep afterwards. Rental boots for all off-ship activities are included. It is mandatory for all guests to bring their own waterproof trousers for shore landings.

Currency

The onboard currency can vary depending on your cruise. Please check with your APT sales consultant or travel agent for details. Settlement of shipboard accounts is accepted via payment with Visa, Mastercard and American Express.

Dining

Meals and drinks are included as per tour itinerary. If you have any special dietary requirements, you must advise these at the time of booking.

Expedition Cruising

Expedition cruises are active and involve regular use of Zodiac vessels. These versatile inflatable boats provide a unique platform for observing wildlife and enjoying landscapes from sea level, enabling you to get closer to the sights. They provide a fast and safe way of going ashore in remote locations and are invaluable for exploration.

Expedition cruises feature a taste of exploration and adventure with an Expedition Team including naturalists, marine biologists, historians, geologists and photographers. A spirit of adventure is encouraged to make the most of spontaneous opportunities as they arise, enriching your cruise experience.

Health and Fitness

The nature of expedition cruising requires regular embarkation and disembarkation of Zodiacs for shore access, as well as wet landings on remote beaches, where footwear will get wet. Guests must be able to climb ramps and step in and out of smaller vessels. Walking frames are not permitted on any shore excursions. It is your responsibility to carry any medication (which may require a cooler bag). Consult your local medical practitioner for any health advice.

Internet and Wi-Fi

Wi-Fi internet is included on board the ships; however, it is limited and not guaranteed. Please note that mobile coverage is not guaranteed during the cruise, especially in remote locations and while the ship is at sea.

Laundry

Seabourn Venture and Seabourn Pursuit offer self-service laundry facilities for your convenience. The Coral Adventurer and Coral Discoverer vessels offer laundry services at an additional expense.

Luggage

As a general rule, airlines permit passengers in economy class to take one piece of luggage that does not exceed 63 inches (160 cm) or weigh more than 44 pounds (20kg).

We advise you to contact your airline carrier or travel agent for specific information prior to departure, as size and weight limitations may vary. Each cruise guest is entitled to take one piece of luggage that does not exceed the above specifications.

Passports

It is required that cruise guests have a valid passport with at least six months' validity from the return date.

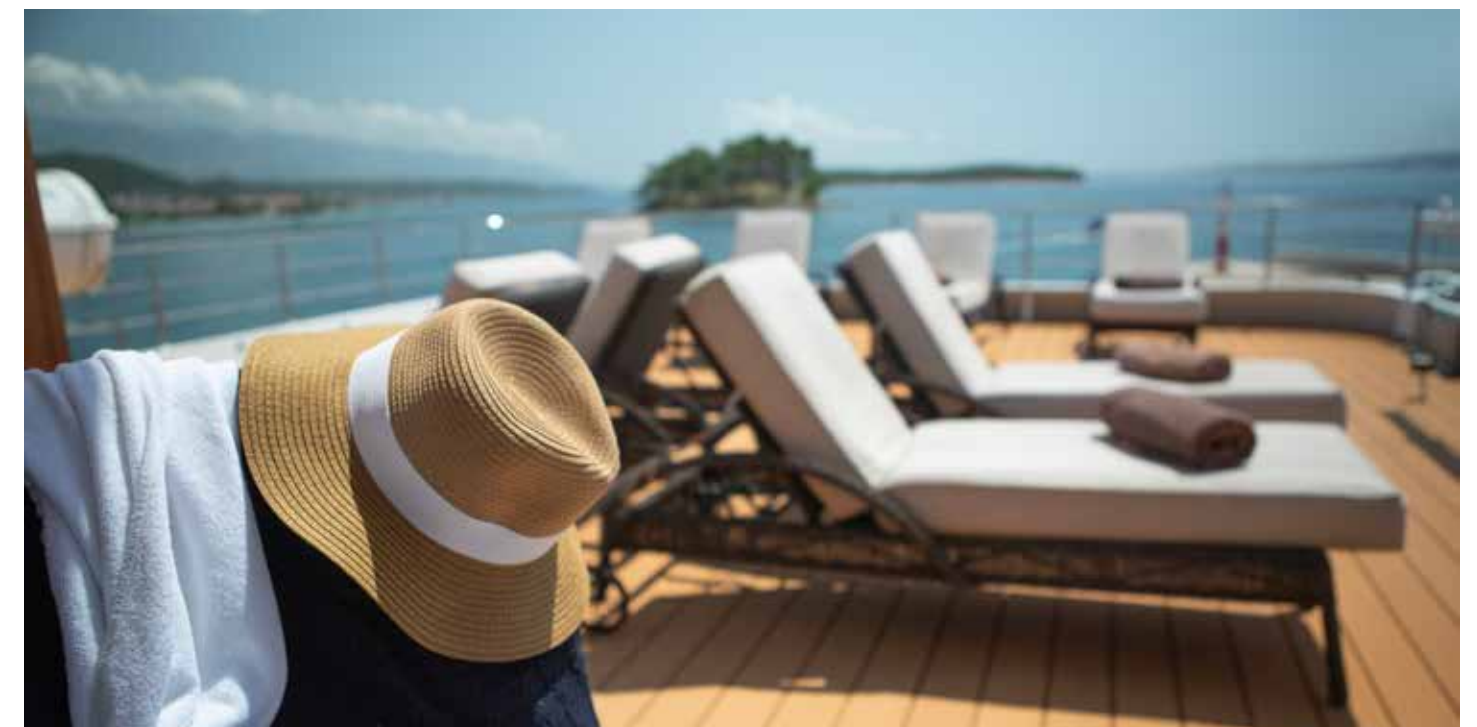

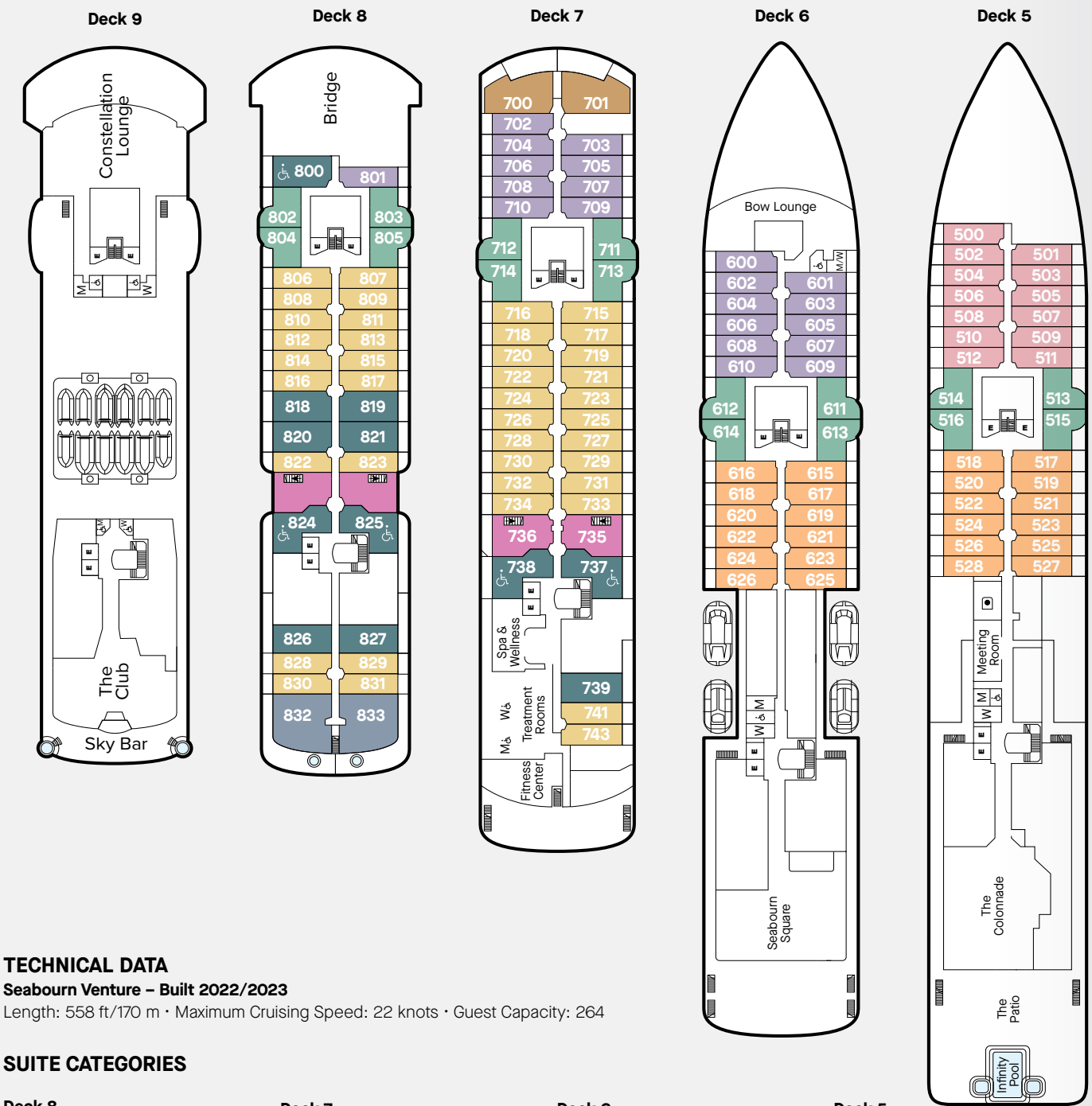
Visas

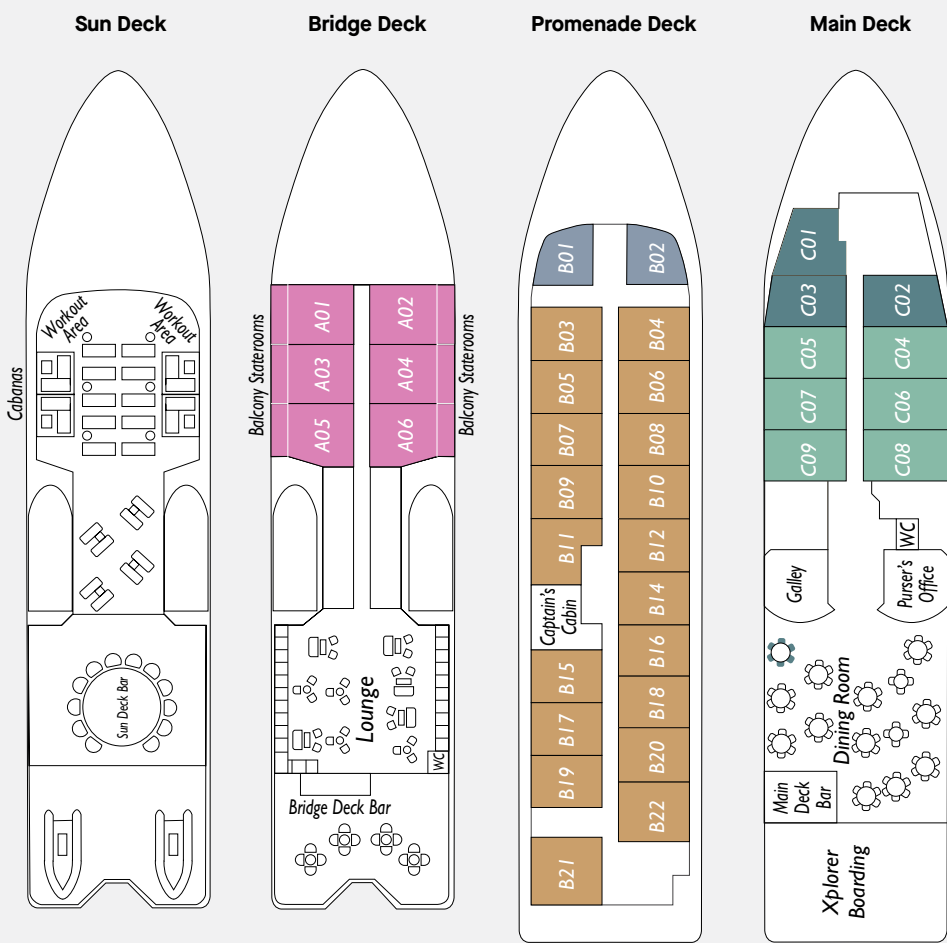
