Depart Knysna and continue your drive along the Garden Route. Visit Monkeyland Primate Reserve, the world's first free-roaming, multi-species primate sanctuary. Continue along the Storms River Mouth via Tsitsikamma Forest on the way to Port Elizabeth.

Stay: Port Elizabeth, Boardwalk Hotel.

Day 8. Port Elizabeth, Johannesburg, Kruger National Park ★

Board an included flight to Kruger National Park via Johannesburg. 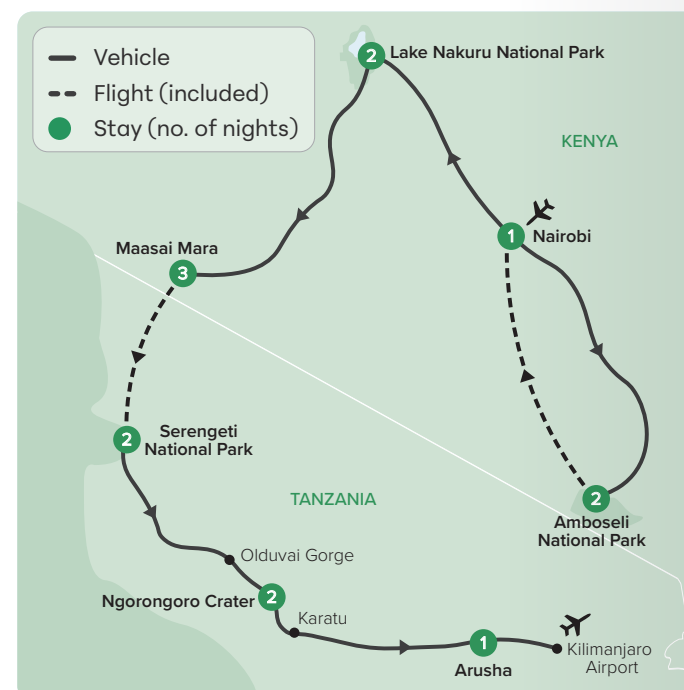

This afternoon, head out on an exhilarating game drive.
Three Nights: Maasai Mara, Zebra Plains Mara Camp or similar.

Day 7. Maasai Mara Perhaps experience the Maasai Mara from the skies on a magical hot-air balloon ride (additional expense — see page 38). Enjoy breakfast as you prepare to head out on another game drive. Return to the lodge for lunch before an afternoon at leisure.
