SEVEN HIGHLIGHTS OF VIETNAM AND CAMBODIA

Linked by the mighty Mekong River, Vietnam and Cambodia are perfectly suited to slow cruising and enriching discoveries on land. Here are seven unmissable experiences on a journey across these captivating countries with Travelmarvel.

1 CRUISE HA LONG BAY

The forest-covered limestone karst peaks rising from the Gulf of Tonkin are the signature image of UNESCO World Heritage-listed Ha Long Bay, its 3,000-odd rocky islands sheltering caves and grottoes. Time slows down as you drift among islands, explore caves by kayak, practise tai chi on deck, and dine on exquisite Southeast Asian cuisine, all the while enveloped by the otherworldly beauty of your surrounds.

MASTER VIETNAMESE CUISINE IN HOI AN

Blessed with extensive coastline, fertile soil, and plenty of rain, Vietnam produces an abundance of fresh ingredients. It's what gives the cuisine its celebrated freshness and balance — and what makes learning to cook Vietnamese cuisine such a rewarding experience. Join a hands-on cooking class at the famous Morning Glory Cooking School to prepare a selection of dishes before sitting down to enjoy your delicious creations.

WATCH THE SUN RISE AT ANGKOR WAT

As one of Southeast Asia's most important archaeological complexes, Cambodia's Angkor Archaeological Park is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the most spectacular sunrise viewpoints on the planet. In the soft glow of dawn, arrive at Angkor Wat, the park's dazzling centrepiece. Witness the sun climb over this incredible wonder, originally built as a Hindu temple and later transformed into a revered Buddhist site. When the lake is filled with water, its shimmering surface reflects the temple's central spires framed by fan palms — a photographer's dream.

STAY AT SHINTA MANI ANGKOR

Renowned American designer Bill Bensley boasts more than 200 resorts, hotels, and palaces under his name — but it's Shinta Mani Angkor that is closest to his heart.

The famous striped courtyard pool — surrounded by lush lawns, elegant palms, frangipani trees, and hand-folded pink lotus flower displays — serves as a shady oasis in the heart of Siem Reap's Royal District, the perfect haven after a day spent exploring the temples.

USE TOURISM AS A FORCE FOR GOOD

Visit Opportunities of Development thru Art (ODA) in Siem Reap and meet children from disadvantaged backgrounds receiving free education through this local charity, supported by Travelmarvel via the OneTomorrow initiative, alongside generous guest donations. Watching the children paint, with the opportunity to purchase their artwork, offers a first-hand experience of the positive impact that tourism can have on local communities.

BE BLESSED BY A BUDDHIST MONK

Approximately 97 per cent of the Cambodian population is Buddhist. Khmer monks renounce material possessions in pursuit of spiritual enlightenment, living a simple, ascetic life. Gain a glimpse into monastic life in Cambodia's former royal capital of Oudong, where you'll experience a Buddhist blessing ceremony at a local monastery, bestowing you with good luck, health, and a safe journey.

TAKE AN AFTERNOON TUK TUK RIDE

On the tiny island of Koh Pen, on a tranquil bend of the Mekong River, you'll hop aboard a local tuk tuk for an afternoon ride. It's an unbeatable way to connect with authentic local life as you travel along shaded lanes, passing colourful markets, ancient temple grounds, and stilted timber houses tucked among tall palms and sandalwood trees.

BETWEEN THE ALPS

With pristine Alps and verdant valleys, Switzerland's dramatic scenery is matched by an exceptional rail network that reaches even its most remote locations in comfort.

From Geneva to Zürich, Travelmarvel's 11-day Switzerland by Rail tour weaves together the country's most iconic journeys through the heart of the Alps: the Glacier Express, Bernina Express, GoldenPass Express and Gotthard Panorama Express. Europe Product Managers Nathan Walker and Sam McPaike share that the itinerary is "designed to include the top four panoramic trains in Switzerland and unmissable stops including Interlaken, St. Moritz, Lake Lucerne, Jungfrauoch and Mount Pilatus."

Among the trains included is the GoldenPass Express, tracing a path through storybook villages and resort towns. "Departing Montreux, you begin a steep ascent into the mountains, and within just 20 minutes are transported into a world of white-tipped peaks and charming chalet villages dotting the landscape. As you approach Interlaken, the track runs parallel to the shimmering waters of Lake Thun, with castles and churches nestled in the mountains, creating a scene of timeless beauty," McPaike notes.

The Glacier Express carries travellers along one of the world's most idyllic rail routes to St. Moritz. "From Andermatt, it climbs to the Oberalp Pass, briefly stopping at the summit before continuing past turquoise-blue lakes and winding rivers towards St. Moritz," Walker shares, noting the panoramic glass windows, comfortable seats and engaging onboard commentary as the train passes many significant sites.

The journey continues to Tirano on the Bernina Express. "You may even spot a local ibex on the mountainside," Walker notes. He describes the ride as breathtaking, with the train surrounded by towering mountains, the highlight being "a stop at Alp Grum, a 2,091-metre-high viewpoint offering panoramic views of the Palù Glacier and Palù Lake."

Beyond the shifting panorama, your Alpine adventure immerses you in the country's outdoor lifestyle and fascinating history, from a scenic cruise of Lake Geneva to a guided tour of Zürich's UNESCO World Heritage-listed Old Town.

When Juwita and I began shaping what would become Travelmarvel's 11-day *Central Australia and Top End Discovery* tour, we saw an opportunity to give guests a whole new experience of the Northern Territory. We knew our guests already love the separate journeys we offer through Central Australia and the Top End, but connecting them with a flight between Alice Springs and Darwin meant missing out on some of the Territory's truly unique moments.

After feedback from our guests backed our intuition that the journey itself mattered just as much as seeing the icons, we decided that this new itinerary would travel overland. This meant we could showcase the region's incredibly diverse scenery while also visiting some of its more character-filled outback towns along the way, striking the perfect balance

between places like Kakadu National Park and quirkier stops like Daly Waters and Aileron.

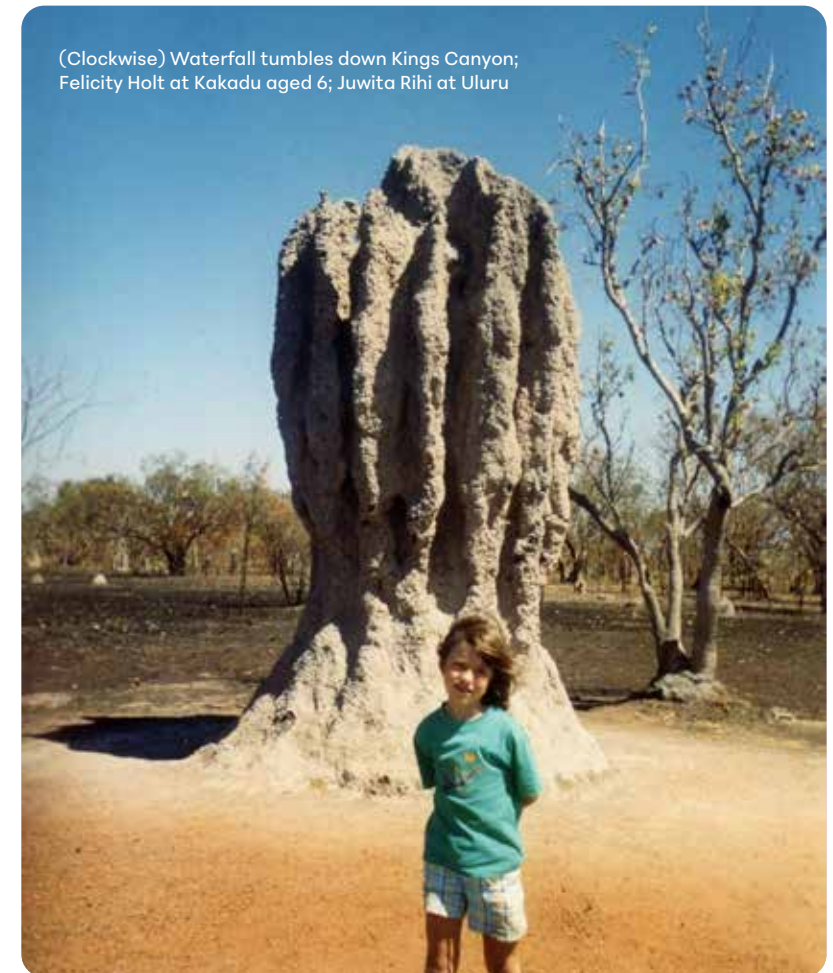
At the beginning, we looked closely at the unique highlights of the region and identified how we could offer our guests a memorable experience. Then we got into the detail to ensure the tour would unfold seamlessly, mapping out the route with careful attention to pacing, travel distances, and the balance between included experiences and free time to explore. We researched accommodation and other points of interest along the way, including a new Insider Experience to immerse our guests in outback life — a sunset barbecue in Alice Springs, followed by a night walk to spot echidnas and bilbies.

These remote destinations require careful planning to create an effortless journey for our guests. Behind the scenes, we worked closely with our Operations Team, whose on-the-ground expertise was invaluable — particularly in refining the route for our custom 4WD vehicles, the ideal way to explore the rugged Australian Outback. We also designed the tour for just 18 guests to ensure a deeply personalised and immersive experience.

For me, the most rewarding part of the process is imagining the joy that this new tour will bring our guests. Whether it's sunrise at Uluru, meeting locals at Daly Waters Pub, or stargazing at Kings Canyon, these are the uniquely Northern Territory moments they'll remember long after the tour is over.

SAFARI AND SANDWICHES

When it comes to alfresco dining, a picnic set within the world's largest intact caldera takes the cake. A Ngorongoro Crater lunch break with Travelmarvel is like a nature documentary come to life.

Tanzania's Ngorongoro Crater is the stage for some of nature's most dramatic scenes. Hippos peer out from freshwater swamps. A lioness stalks a wildebeest in a thrilling hunt. A critically endangered black rhino steps out of hiding to graze in the grasslands. This World Heritage-listed wonderland is a highlight of Travelmarvel's 14-day *Kenya and Tanzania Adventure* — and the setting for a picnic like no other.

A Wildlife Utopia

If you're a wildlife enthusiast, you've come to the right place. The vast Ngorongoro Conservation Area stretches from Serengeti National Park to the eastern reaches of the Great Rift Valley, shapeshifting from highland plains to golden savanna, wildlife-rich wetlands and fever tree forests, concealing all sorts of wildlife — including the Big Five (lion, leopard, rhinoceros, elephant, and African buffalo).

Ngorongoro Crater is home to over 25,000 animals. The area's fertile soil and permanent waterholes attract black-spotted hyenas, elephants, antelopes, and one of the world's highest concentrations of lion prides. During the annual Great Migration — when over two million wildebeest, zebra and gazelles move across the Serengeti-Mara ecosystem — the dense columns of animals moving through this landscape can be seen from outer space.

Keen birdwatchers can delight in spotting over 500 species of birds, from pink flamingos to ostriches and rainbow-hued Fischer's lovebirds. On an exhilarating safari experience, you may spot these remarkable animals and more across this extraordinary landscape.

WILD ENCOUNTERS IN GLACIER BAY

From thunderous calving glaciers to breaching whales and soaring eagles, Alaska's Glacier Bay National Park offers an unforgettable immersion into the wild.

Alaska Untamed

After several days cruising north along Alaska's Inside Passage, stopping to explore frontier towns and watching dramatic rocky headlands pass by, you'll wake to the phenomenal sight of sheltered fjords, iceberg-strewn waters, and rivers of ice carved between snow-capped peaks.

Glide towards the glacier and take in its staggering scale. A valley of rugged ice spills into the glassy lake, ending abruptly in a towering frozen cliff. Perhaps you'll hear the thunderous crack of ice calving — great chunks breaking free and crashing into the water below — echoing through the pristine silence.

A Marine Haven

Beyond the sheer beauty of your surrounds, the abundant wildlife inhabiting this icy terrain allows for exciting wildlife spotting. From whales and orcas to sea otters and seals, these pristine waters teem with marine life. Park Rangers will board the ship to provide expert narration on the area's geological wonders and the marine life to look out for, with plenty of time for questions.

Humpback whales migrate to Glacier Bay every summer and the sight of them breaching as you watch from the ship is truly unforgettable. Harbour seals lounge on icebergs and often use these icy islands to give birth to their young as they provide a safe place away from predators like orcas — which you may also spot swimming in pods throughout the Bay. Curious sea otters, barking sea lions and shy porpoises also call this spectacular setting their home, so keep an eye out and ask your Park Ranger for the best place to look.

Wild Encounters from Shore to Sky

Above, you may spot eagles in the trees or resting on icebergs. Kittiwake colonies nest on barren cliffs, and you may see these birds using icebergs as a vantage point as they scout for fish. Bright-beaked tufted puffins nest on cliffs and might be spotted feeding on fish.

Brown bears sometimes meander through the intertidal zone and are often seen on barren mountainsides or beaches. It's always a thrilling sight when bears are spotted on their solitary rambles. Also keep an eye out for moose munching on the willows found throughout Glacier Bay.

Together, these encounters create a rare window into a truly wild ecosystem, where nature calls the shots. As glaciers calve, eagles circle, and humpbacks breach, all you can do is watch, exhale, and surrender to the moment.

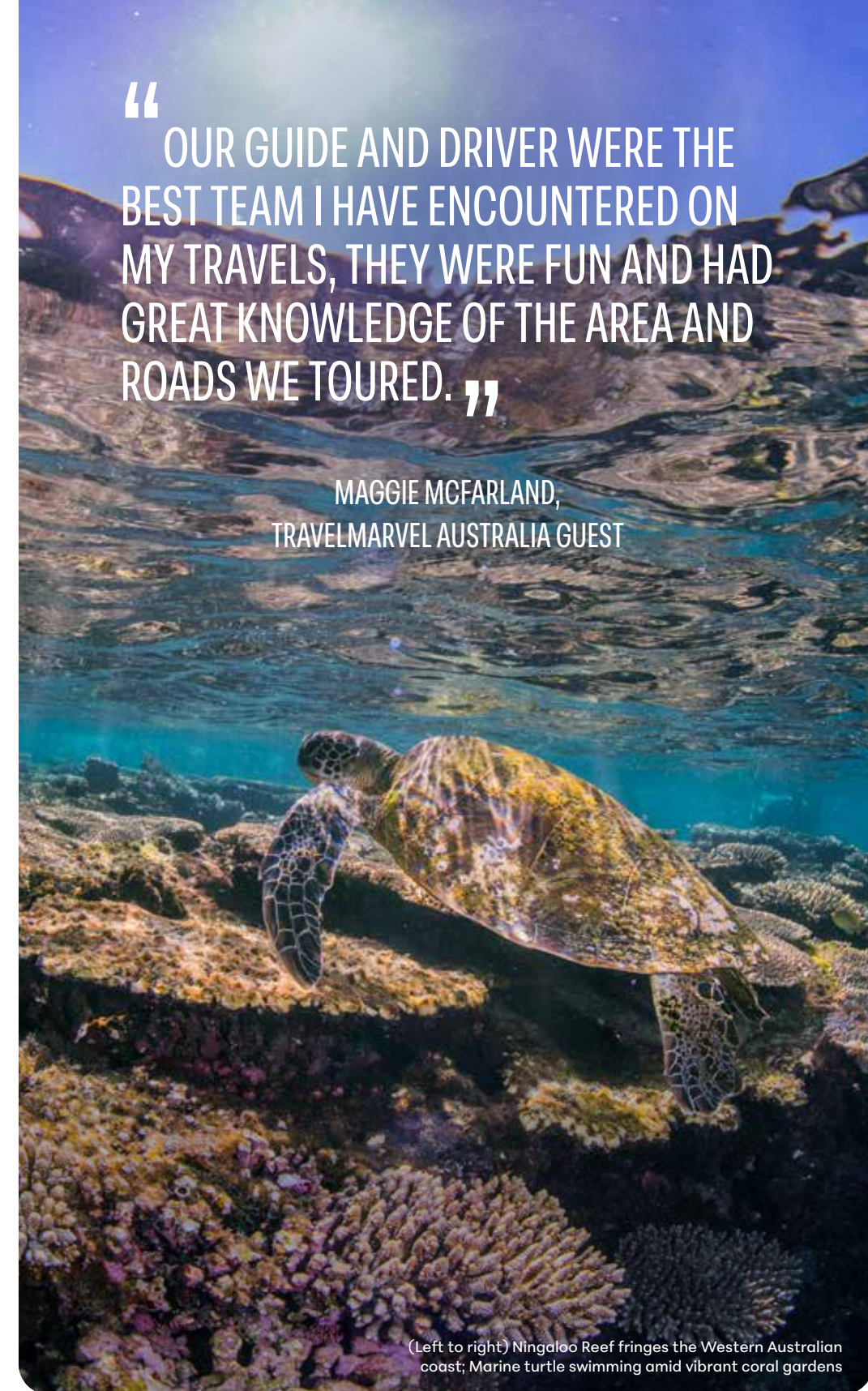

Framed by craggy gorges and ochre limestone cliffs, Ningaloo Reef beckons — where white sand meets crystal-clear waters, and beneath the surface lies a captivating ocean oasis.

If you dream of encountering an underwater world akin to David Attenborough's remarkable *Blue Planet*, put Australia's World Heritage-listed Ningaloo Reef at the top of your travel wish list. Stretching more than 300 kilometres along Cape Range National Park and the remote Western Australian coast, this thriving marine paradise is widely recognised as the longest fringing reef in the world. Its close proximity to shore means sparkling lagoons teeming with life lie just metres from the sand.

Embark on an epic off-road journey on Travelmarvel's 12-day *West Coast Discovery by 4WD*, where a cruise through Ningaloo Marine Park is sure to be a highlight. Witness an astonishing diversity of sea life — no specialised diving equipment or high-definition drones required. Beneath crystal-clear turquoise waters, coral gardens shelter kaleidoscopic schools of tropical fish alongside seasonal visitors from the open ocean, acting as a sanctuary for many endangered species.

It is one of the few places on Earth where whale sharks — the gentle giants of the sea with their star-studded skin — regularly gather close to shore. Year-round, dugongs, nicknamed sea cows, graze across vast seagrass meadows, while manta rays glide through reef cleaning stations, where smaller fish devotedly remove parasites and dead skin. Dolphins arc through the shallows. Reef sharks patrol the outer edges of the reef. And after maturing over 20 to 30 years, loggerhead turtles use the Earth's magnetic field as a natural compass, navigating thousands of kilometres back to the very beach where they hatched to nest.

This is Sea Country — a sacred, living entity of deep significance to the Traditional Owners of Nyینگulu (Ningaloo) Reef, the Baiyungu, Thalanyji and Yinigurdira peoples. Artefacts found in rock shelters and caves across the Cape Range Peninsula show Aboriginal people have lived along this coast for more than 32,000 years, with some archaeologists proposing up to 60,000 years of habitation. So when you visit Ningaloo Reef, not only do you encounter an extraordinary abundance of marine life — you also step into a living cultural landscape defined by tens of thousands of years of Aboriginal heritage.

FUN FACTS

Whale sharks visit annually

From March to August, Ningaloo reef becomes one of the few places in the world where whale sharks regularly congregate in near-shore waters, feeding on seasonal plankton blooms.

Mass coral spawning transforms the reef into an underwater snowstorm

Every March and April, the reef comes alive in a synchronised mass coral spawning event, creating an extraordinary underwater bloom that briefly transforms the ocean into a spectacular drifting pink cloud.

Ningaloo Reef is home to three of the world's seven sea turtle species

Green, loggerhead and hawksbill turtles are all a regular presence in the reef's protected waters, making it a vital nesting and feeding ground.

Migrating humpbacks use it as a coastal highway

Tens of thousands of humpback whales journey from Antarctica to the warmer waters of the Kimberley and back during their annual migration, with many passing through Ningaloo Reef.

One of the world's oldest known pieces of jewellery was found at a site overlooking Ningaloo Reef

A 32,000-year-old shell necklace was excavated from the Mandu Mandu Creek rock-shelter overlooking Ningaloo Reef in 1985, among the earliest known Aboriginal artefacts demonstrating personal ornamentation found in Australia.

Set within the lush Atlantic Forest near Iguacu National Park, the renowned Parque das Aves sanctuary invites you to get close to the country's remarkable tropical birds, with more than half of its residents rescued and rehabilitated from trafficking and mistreatment.

Wander through leafy aviaries where the forest comes alive around you. More than 1,300 birds across 143 species fly overhead, 90 per cent of them native to this extraordinary ecosystem. From the striking plumage of the blue-and-yellow macaw to the brilliant hues of the green-billed toucan, this is nature's riot of colour — one to rival the most dazzling displays of Rio's famed Carnival.

Ride the Rapids

For adventure seekers, there's nothing quite like feeling the spray of water on your face as a speedboat brings you right underneath the roaring cascades of Iguazú Falls. Meaning 'big water' in the Indigenous Guaraní or Tupi language, this natural wonder is formed by around 275 waterfalls stretching an incredible 2.7 kilometres across the Argentina–Brazil border.

According to Guaraní legend, a serpent god who ruled the Iguazú River created the Falls in a fiery rage when the woman he planned to marry fled with her mortal lover in a canoe. He split the river in two, trapping the pair in the 82-metre-high Devil's Throat, the tallest cascade.

As you skirt along powerful rapids, the scene feels Jurassic in every sense. Gargantuan boulders line the riverbanks while cliffs of ancient volcanic rock soar overhead, crowned by thriving jungle. Rainbows and even moonbows are constant occurrences in this realm of wild mist. Nature's putting on a show, and you've got a front-row seat.
