Price Validity

Prices will be confirmed at time of booking and honoured for up to seven days. All holidays are subject to availability at the time of booking.

Credit and Debit Card Surcharges

If you pay APT by credit or debit card, surcharges will apply. In the case of credit cards, a surcharge of between 1% and 3% (depending on the card used) is added to the tour price. In the case of debit cards, a charge of 0.5% is added to the tour price.

Travel Insurance

Once air tickets are issued, amendment and cancellation fees and conditions apply and, in some cases, are non-refundable.

ansfers
