ASWAN'S MODERN MARVEL

A triumph of modern engineering, the Aswan High Dam reshaped Egypt's bond with the Nile — controlling floods, generating hydroelectric power, and enabling fertile year-round agriculture. Its creation gave rise to Lake Nasser, one of the largest man-made reservoirs in the world.

ABU SIMBEL

Commissioned over 3,000 years ago, the temples of Abu Simbel were built by Ramesses II to honour himself and the gods, projecting his power and divine status. In the 1960s, these monumental temples were carefully relocated to save them from the rising waters of Lake Nasser caused by the Aswan High Dam — a feat that preserved one of Egypt's most iconic ancient sites.

AMMAN AND THE DEAD SEA


Jordan's capital, Amman, is a city of contrast, where the ancient and modern reside side by side. Desert roads lead to the mysterious Dead Sea, where you can float effortlessly in the salt-rich waters.

WADI RUM DESERT VALLEY

Discover the desert majesty of Wadi Rum, where vast sandstone valleys and ancient rock carvings stretch beneath endless skies. Explore this UNESCO World Heritage-listed landscape by open-air jeep and enjoy a star-lit dinner with authentic Bedouin hospitality.

Hidden deep within Jordan's windblown deserts, Petra is a World Heritage-listed wonder. A walk through its narrow gorge — flanked by towering vertical walls — leads to Al Khazneh, also known as the Treasury, intricately carved into the ancient rose-red rock face.



Day 1. Arrive Cairo Be met at the airport and transferred to your hotel. This evening, meet your Tour Director and fellow travellers during a Welcome Dinner.

Three Nights: Cairo Marriott Hotel.

Day 2. Cairo This morning, join your Egyptologist Tour Director to explore the Giza Plateau and the mysteries of its pyramids. Nearby, the limestone-carved Great Sphinx stands sentinel. Learn about its significance and the construction of these ancient wonders. Continue to the Grand Egyptian Museum — a striking blend of modern design and ancient artefacts. Return to your hotel for an evening at leisure.

Day 3. Cairo Today, explore Cairo's historic Old Town. Choose to Enhance Your Journey with a guided tour of Memphis and Saqqara, or discover Coptic Cairo and its Saints Sergius and Bacchus Church — believed to stand above a resting spot once used by the Holy Family (additional expense — see pages 30-31). Later, soak up the vibrant atmosphere of the Khan el-Khalili bazaar.

Day 4. Cairo, Luxor, Embark Ship Fly to Luxor this morning and explore Karnak Temple, a vast complex of sanctuaries, pylons and obelisks. Transfer to the Nile River and board Travelmarvel Sirius, settling in with lunch on board. Later, visit Luxor Temple, once the centre of Egypt's most important religious festival. This evening, enjoy a captain's Welcome Dinner as your ship sets sail for Dendera.

Day 5. Luxor, Esna 🛊

Early this morning, visit the Dendera Temple complex — one of Egypt's best-preserved ancient sites. With your Egyptologist Tour Director, explore the Temple of Hathor, known for its astronomical ceiling and intricate reliefs, and wander through ancient spaces including the Sacred Lake. Return to your ship for lunch and enjoy a scenic sail back to Luxor. This afternoon, you may wish to continue exploring the East Bank with free time before an evening sail to Esna. BLD

Day 6. Edfu, Aswan 🖈

After breakfast, visit the Temple of Khnum at Esna, dedicated to Khnum, the ram-headed god of creation. Admire its towering columns, lotus carvings and astronomical ceiling featuring the twelve signs of the Zodiac. This afternoon, travel to Edfu to explore one of Egypt's best-preserved temples — a grand sandstone structure honouring the falcon god Horus. Join your Egyptologist Tour Director to uncover stories of ancient festivals once held here. Return to your ship for dinner as you sail towards Aswan for an overnight stay.

Day 7. Aswan 🛊

In serene and storied Aswan, discovery awaits. This morning, tour the High Dam, the Unfinished Obelisk and the beautifully preserved Philae Temple. Enjoy free time or Enhance Your Journey with an optional High Tea at the iconic Old Cataract Hotel (additional expense). This afternoon, glide along the Nile aboard a traditional felucca at sunset. Later, you may opt to visit Aswan's vibrant Night Market (additional expense). BLD

Day 8. Abu Simbel, Kom Ombo Fly to the awe-inspiring temples of Abu Simbel. With your Egyptologist guide, explore this monumental complex carved into solid rock during the reign of Ramesses II, and admire its towering statues and intricate carvings. Discover how this UNESCO World Heritage-listed site was relocated in a remarkable international effort to save it from rising waters. Return to your ship for lunch, then sail north along the Nile towards Kom Ombo. Relax on deck and take in scenes of daily life before docking overnight.

Day 9. Kom Ombo, Luxor This morning, step ashore to explore the Kom Ombo Temple — a rare double temple dedicated to Sobek, the crocodile god, and Horus, the falcon god of kingship.

Admire its symmetrical design and Roman-era reliefs revealing ancient Egyptian medical knowledge. Afterwards, enjoy a leisurely sail back to Luxor. This evening, you may choose to Enhance Your Journey with the captivating Sound and Light Show at Karnak Temple (additional expense). Dock overnight in Luxor.

Day 10. Luxor Discover the towering Colossi of Memnon, then explore Luxor — the world's largest open-air museum. Visit the Valleys of the Kings and Queens, and the dramatic cliffside mortuary temple of Hatshepsut, honouring one of Egypt's most powerful rulers. Wander through ancient tombs adorned with intricate hieroglyphs, each telling stories of dynasties long past. This evening, enjoy a special Farewell Dinner on board as you reflect on your journey.

Day 11. Luxor, Disembark Ship, Depart Cairo This morning after breakfast, take an included flight back to Cairo airport, where your Egypt adventure comes to an end.
