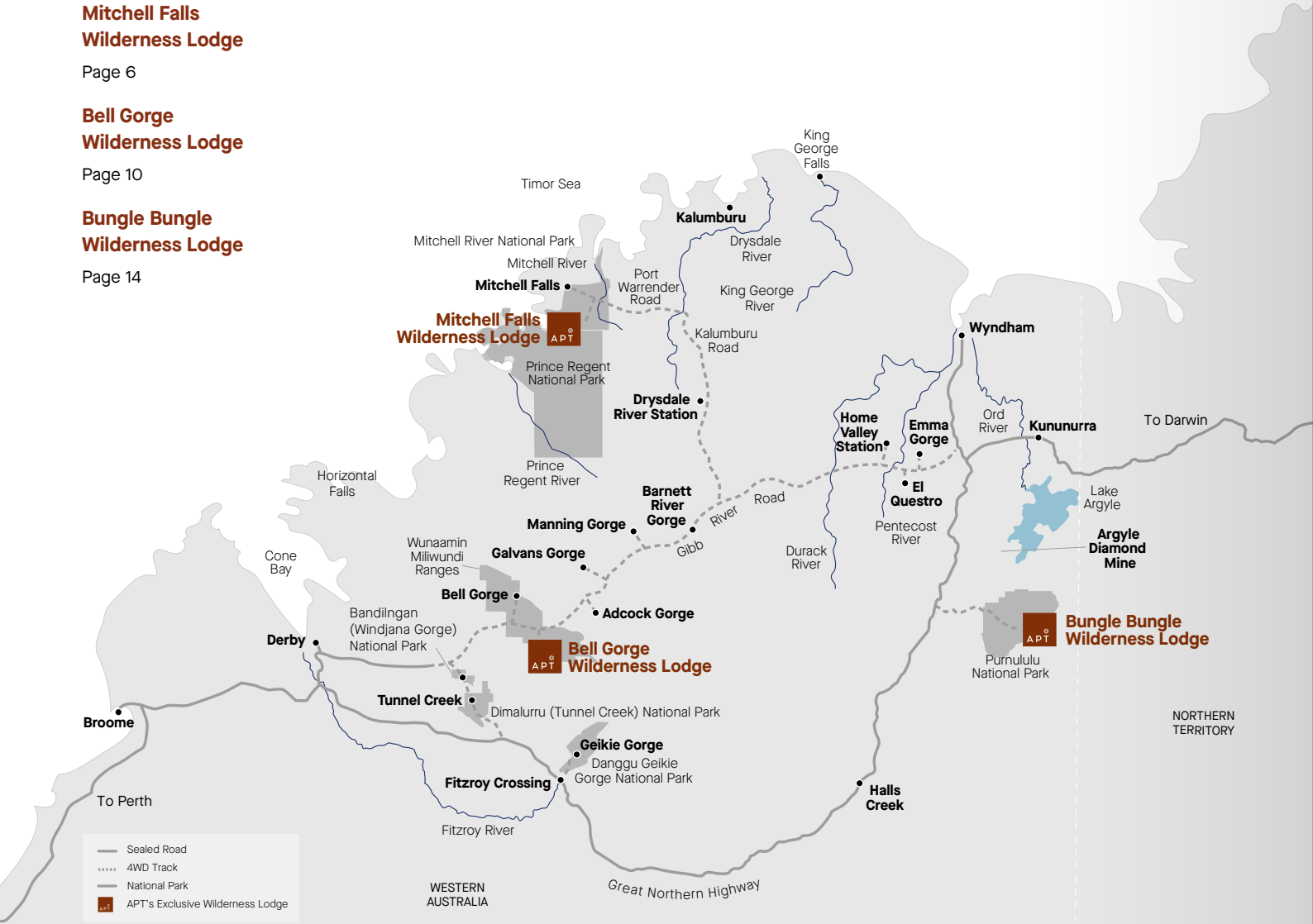

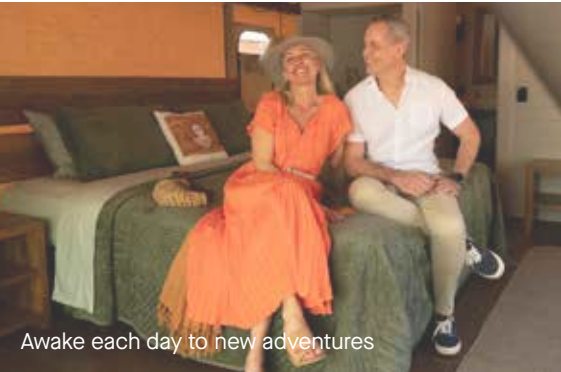

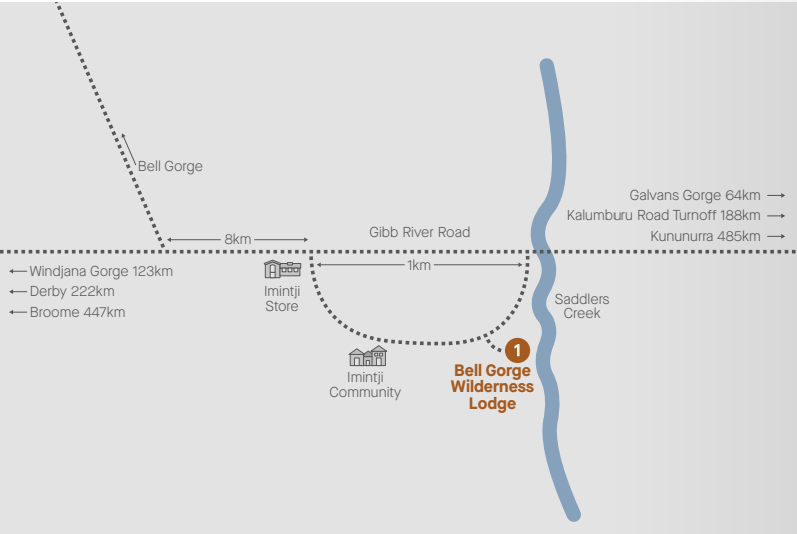

Situated 200 metres off the Gibb River Road and close to the Imintji Indigenous community, the lodge takes full advantage of its prime Indigenous-owned site, and offers expansive views of the Wunaamin Miliwundi Ranges. Located near Bell, Galvans and Manning gorges, as well as Windjana Gorge and Tunnel Creek, it provides the ideal base for exploring the local surrounds.

Bell Gorge Wilderness Lodge offers superior tented cabins with large private en suites, fully equipped with hot water and flushing toilets for your convenience. 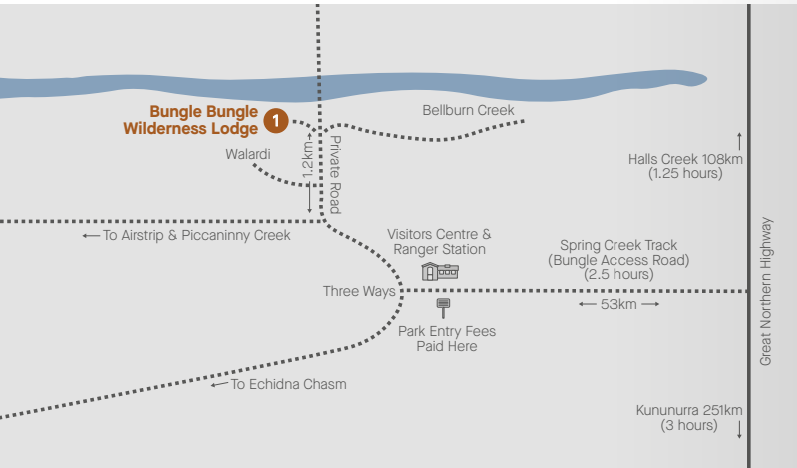

Terms and Conditions

The following terms and conditions ('booking conditions') form the basis of your contract with Australian Pacific Touring Pty Ltd ('APT', 'KWA', 'we' or 'our'). Please read them carefully as they set out your and our respective rights and obligations. By asking us to confirm your booking, we are entitled to assume that you have had the opportunity to read and have read all of these booking conditions; that you agree to them; and that you agree to them applying to the holiday arrangements that you book with us and which we agree to make, provide or perform (as applicable) as part of our contract with you.

BEFORE YOU BOOK

Prices – Deposits – Discounts – Payments

Your booking price will be set out in this contract unless it is varied by advertising or a special offer or is changed after the publication date for any reason, including without limitation, to cover changes in government taxes and charges, exchange rate variations, fuel surcharges, airline charges, a force majeure event or other material increases by suppliers.

A security deposit of 10% of your booking is due with seven days. Once you pay your deposit your holiday package price is guaranteed (except for any changes resulting from a force majeure event – see website for full details).

Final payment of the balance of your holiday is due 30 days prior for wilderness lodge accommodation, unless otherwise stated in the terms of a special offer. If booking within these time frames, full payment will be required at the time of booking. APT reserves the right to cancel any ticket or booking or to refuse to carry any passenger where payment has not been received by APT within the specified time. All fares and charges are in the local currency.

If APT is unable to confirm your reservation, all monies will be refunded.

Child rates apply at our wilderness lodges for children three to 12 years but we do not provide any specific family accommodation or facilities for children. Children under three years are not permitted. Accommodation at Mitchell Falls, Standard Tents at Bungle Bungle is twin configuration for a max of two guests per tent, while Superior tents at Bell Gorge and the Bungle Bungle provide a rollaway at an additional cost for a triple share option.

Cancellation Policy

For all holiday packages in this brochure, the following APT cancellation fees apply:

Days of Notice	Fee Per Person
31 days or more	no penalty
30-15 days	20% of total lodge stay
14-8 days	50% of total lodge stay
7 days or less	100% of total lodge stay

Group cancellation policy of five or more tents – on application. All cancellations must be received in writing by APT and are not effective until this notification has been received. If your holiday has commenced, 100% of the full holiday package price is charged. There is no refund for unused services or if portions of the holiday package are missed. You acknowledge that the amounts estimated under the Cancellation Policy are reasonable and represent a genuine pre-estimate of APT's loss.

Amendment Fees

A charge of \$50 will apply to any addition or modification requested after the original booking has been confirmed.

Credit & Debit Card Surcharges

If you pay APT by credit or debit card, a surcharge of between 0.5% and 3% will be added your accommodation price.

Smoking

Smoking is not permitted in rooms or lodge public areas.

Medical Assistance

If you require medical attention, medical services will be contacted on request or if we deem it to be necessary. You are responsible for all charges that result from visiting a medical facility, or for a medical practitioner visiting you. APT is not responsible for the type or quality of the medical services you may receive.

Health and Fitness

A good level of fitness and health is required as our lodges are in remote areas. Nearby activities vary in degrees of difficulty. It is your responsibility to carry any medication you require and we recommend carrying medication in your hand luggage from the time you leave home.

Passengers Needing Special Assistance

Any disability or medical condition requiring special attention must be reported to APT at the time of booking. For safety reasons, passengers in wheelchairs cannot be carried on to vehicles and light aircraft. APT is unable to

provide individual assistance to any guest for walking, dining, boarding or alighting coaches or other transportation vehicles or other personal needs. Guests requiring assistance (mental or physical) must be accompanied by a companion capable of providing all necessary assistance.

Service Inquiries

If a problem occurs during your stay, advise your Lodge Host or guide so that steps can be taken to resolve the matter immediately. If you remain dissatisfied, any complaint must be made in writing to us within 30 days.

Travel Insurance

Travel insurance is not included in your holiday package. We strongly recommend you purchase comprehensive travel insurance at the time of booking that includes (without limitation) coverage for the cost of your holiday package, medical expenses, loss of luggage, and airfare charges that may occur due to cancellation, impossibility of performance or other frustration, disruption, loss of deposit or strikes.
